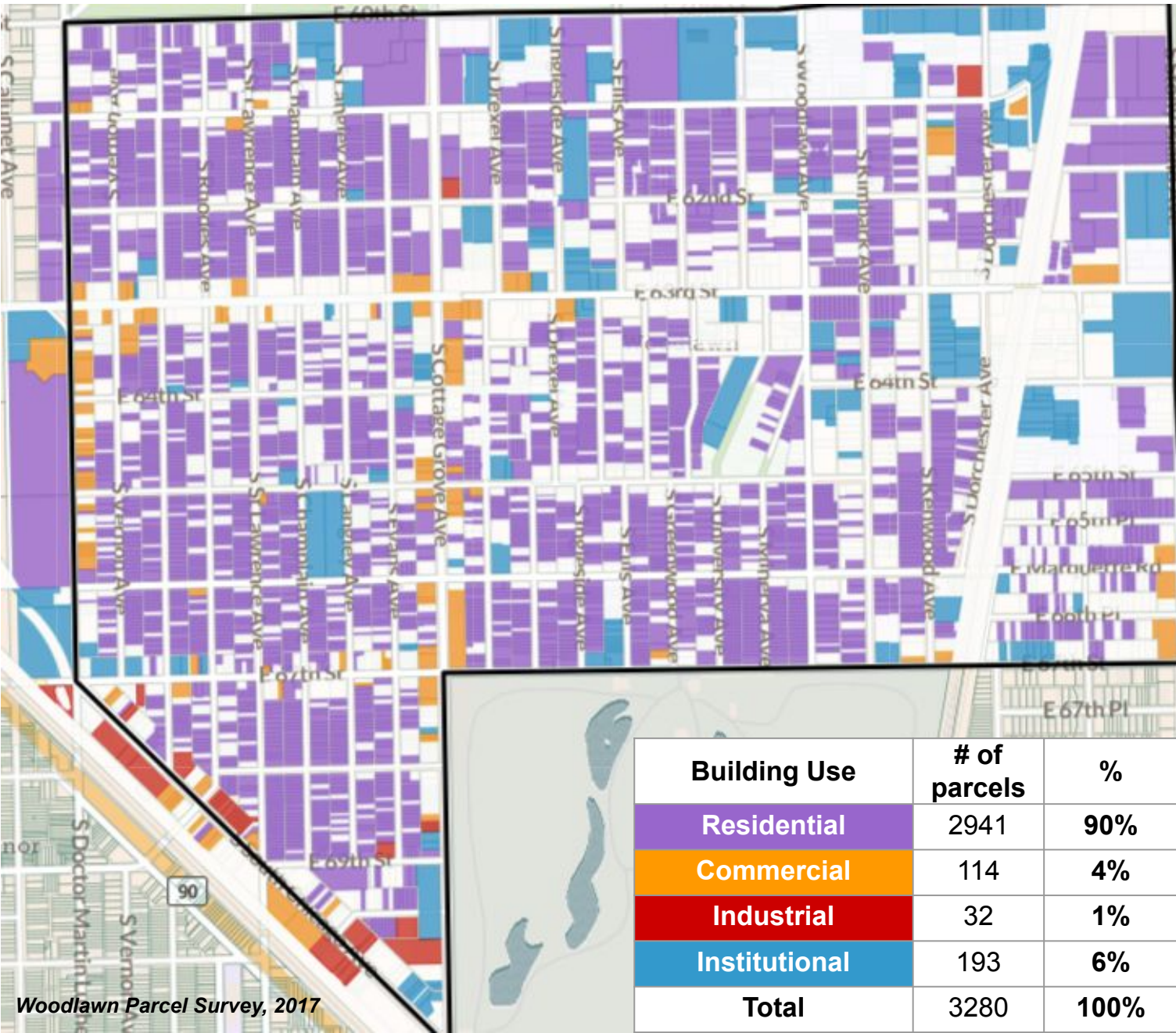


### Question 4: What is this building used for?



A structure’s use was categorized into four major types--Residential, Commercial, Industrial, and Institutional--each of which had its own set of subtypes to further detail the property’s use.

About 90% of Woodlawn’s structures are designed for residential use. Commercial properties are primarily located along Cottage Grove and King Drive south of 63rd. Space for business is both sparse and underutilized, with many commercial properties vacant and/or boarded up. Additional small patches of commercial are located near 65th and Stony Island and along South Chicago Avenue. There, those commercial properties commingle with Woodlawn’s cluster of industrial properties.

Institutional properties make up the second largest use category after residential properties and include public and private schools, nonprofits and churches and municipal buildings. The University of Chicago, Mount Carmel High School, and Apostolic Church of God represent three Woodlawn institutions owning large amounts of property.
